Over the years, we've made it our mission to make skis for the good of skiing. It might seem a little pretentious or self-involved, but we're still here. Doing just that. And we don't plan on stopping any time soon.





It's how I ended up all those years ago working on developing and rethinking ski design in general. In the last couple of years, I've been inspired by the non-traditional fish snowboards out there, and it made me reexamine directional skis. And when

we introduced swallowtail skis – with both the Pescado and Sakana – I wanted to harness the positives of the directional skis – stability at speed, long effective edge, and edge grip – into shapes and designs that still allowed me to ollie, butter, and play with turn shape.
