


Adding convexity to the tip and tails of the Sir Francis Bacon and Outline was a massive challenge – one that was harder than anything I’ve ever undertaken in the past. With this Convex contouring, we’re able to loosen the overall feel when the tip or tail is pressured. Similar to a surfboard, the convexity

adds dimensionality to the ways in which you can pressure, feather, and stand on a ski. The end result is a ski that slashes better, butters with more control, improves float, and adds speed.



I grew up skiing directional skis. Skis with little sidecut that were super stiff, but still pretty fun. But I felt limited by those skis. It’s how I ended up all those years ago working on developing and rethinking ski design in general. In the last couple of years, I’ve been inspired by the non-traditional fish snowboards out there, and it made me reexamine directional skis. And when

we introduced swallowtail skis – with both the Pescado and Sakana – I wanted to harness the positives of the directional skis – stability at speed, long effective edge, and edge grip – into shapes and designs that still allowed me to ollie, butter, and play with turn shape.
